Stepping into **4th Spot Kitchen & Bar** at 2620 4 St NW, Calgary, you instantly feel the buzz of a neighbourhood favourite and the comfort of a well-loved menu. As I sat down with a friend for lunch, our shared goal was simple: explore the menu, savour the highlights, and then recount our experience. The “4Th Spot Menu” took us on a fun, flavour-rich journey-from starters through tacos, to pizzas (including gluten-free options)-and here’s how it all played out.

We began with the “Appys ‘n Intros” section of the 4th Spot Menu, and it delivered. The **Inferno Prawns** stood out immediately: juicy tiger prawns pan-seared in a spicy buttery tomato sauce, drizzled with lime crema and served with garlic focaccia. The heat was balanced, the prawns fresh, and it set a high bar for the meal. Then there was **Jiaozi Dumplings**-five pan-fried dumplings with chicken and veggies, teriyaki drizzle, sesame seed and green onion garnish, with soy-ginger ponzu on the side. The textures and flavours were spot on. For fun, we also shared **Porky’s Poutine**: hand-cut Kennebec fries tossed in maple bacon seasoning, topped with Quebec cheese curds, house-made gravy, slow-smoked pulled pork and lumberjack BBQ sauce. It’s indulgent, messy, and exactly what you crave when you want comfort with character.

Moving into the taco section-another highlight of the 4Th Spot Menu-we opted for two varieties. The “**New**” **Senior Sisig Tacos** featured Filipino-style pork sisig, shredded lettuce, jalapeño, red onion and house-made calamansi citrus crema, topped with pork chicharrones. These brought a fresh, zesty twist. The **Sun Is Shining Fish Tacos** offered a lighter but equally satisfying option: Southwestern-spiced haddock, shredded lettuce, mango salsa and avocado-lime crema. Each tortilla held a balance between crisp, soft and tangy, making them a standout among the tacos on the menu.

When it came to pizzas, the “Create Your Own Pizza” and the “Karouzo’s Family Pizza / Gluten Free Crust” sections of the 4Th Spot Menu really shine. For those who love build-your-own freedom, the 12” plain cheese or pepperoni base is a strong canvas. But we were drawn to the gluten-free 10” options: the **10” GF Deluxe Pizza** (pepperoni, ham,

green pepper, mushroom), the **10” GF Veg Out Pizza** (mushrooms, green pepper, red onion, black olives, pineapple, fresh tomato) and the **10” GF The Butcher Pizza** (pepperoni, beef, bacon, sausage). What I loved was how the crust held up-gluten-free but crisp, with toppings that didn’t overwhelm. Even the simpler **10” GF Cheese Pizza** showed that the kitchen cares about all guests, accommodating dietary needs without compromise. The toppings were generous, the flavours bold, and the crust had a great chew.

Throughout the meal, the friendly atmosphere of the place came through-staff were welcoming, and the vibe was casual yet lively, which matched the menu’s dual focus: comfort food done with style. The 4Th Spot Menu caters to many moods-whether you’re in for a sharing starters session, taco night, or a full pizza feast. And what struck me most was the variety: from bold spice to mellow comfort, vegetarian-friendly veg-out pizzas, gluten-free crusts, tacos that mix cultures, and plenty of classic favourites.

If I were to pick a “must-try” trio on this menu, I’d go: the Inferno Prawns (to begin), the Senior Sisig Tacos (as a mid-course surprise), and the 10” GF Veg Out Pizza (to round things off with something hearty and vegetable-rich). The interplay between each dish means you can go bold with flavours and then comfort yourself with something cheesy and familiar.

In summary, the 4Th Spot Menu at 4th Spot Kitchen & Bar offers an inviting mix of starters, tacos and pizzas (including gluten-free), all prepared with attention and flair. It’s a place where you can comfortably share plates with friends, indulge in a full meal, or simply grab a slice of something comforting. If you’re in Calgary and looking for a menu that hits both casual and creative, this is one to visit.
